



- Vein of Marshall.
- ✓VOM is an embryological remnant of the left superior vena cava (SVC). It is an "oblique" vein that drains into the [coronary sinus].



- Vein of #Marshall.
- ✓VOM plays a key role in atrial arrhythmogenesis
- ✓ Has electrical interaction w/ pulmonary veins
- ✓A source of ectopic beats that trigger #Afib
- Several studies confirmed that:



- ✓VOM ablation is an effective method to create ablation in the mitral isthmus region.
- ✓In persistent AF, catheter-based alcohol ablation of VOM improves outcomes of PV ablation for #AFib


